Lubic is the founder and President Emeritus of D.C. Development Family Center. She was the General Director of the Maternity Center Association for 25 years and, in 1983, she founded it's offshoot, the National Association of Child Bearing Centers. She was appointed and expert consultant in the Office of Public Health and Science, U.S. Department of Health, and Human Services.
