The Emergency Room is designed to take care of any known or potentially life-threatening medical condition or injury that risks death or disability without immediate medical intervention such as:

- **Chest pain/discomfort, nausea, shortness of breath, severe headache, lightheadedness, fainting, uncontrolled high blood pressure**
- **Facial drooping, arm weakness, difficulty or trouble speaking, confusion, loss of vision, double vision, blurry vision, seizure**
- **Severe abdominal pain, coughing up blood, blood in your stool, fever**
- **Inhaled smoke or poisonous fumes, drug overdose, suicidal thoughts**
- **Electric shock, severe burns, allergic reaction, broken bones, trauma**
- **Severe back pain, wound infection, choking**
